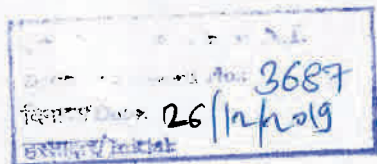
Sub: Minutes of 29th Meeting of HBNI's Board of Studies in Life Sciences

The following agenda items were discussed:

1. Consideration of applications for recognition as Ph.D. guides and PG-Teacher in Life Sciences.

Seven applications for recognition as Ph.D. Guide and PG- Teacher of HBNI in the area of Life Sciences were considered by Board of Studies (Life Sciences). One case for Faculty from BARC was deferred by BOS-LS as Project proposal not well written and advised to publish paper. Six cases from BARC were recommended by BOS-LS as PG-Teacher. (Details are shown in **Annexure I. Suggestion is given that the person applying for the faculty should have Orcid account for verification of documents.**

2. Approval of examiners for synopsis of Ph.D. Theses submitted by Five students:

Synopsis of five Ph.D. thesis in Life Sciences of 2 student from BARC and 3 students from NISER were discussed along with the list of examiners suggested by their respective Doctoral Committee. The necessary requirements of (i) successful completion of course work and OGCE, (ii) four doctoral committee reports, and (iii) at least one journal publication, have been fulfilled by the student of TMC-ACTREC. The committee recommended a list of 6 examiners for Ph. D. thesis as shown in **Annexure II.**

3. Academic Extension for 7th year of 2 Ph.D. students, enrolled in Ph. D. Programme in Life Sciences of HBNI.

Academic Extension for 7th year of 2 Ph.D. students from BARC were discussed in detail. 1 year extension was approved by BOS-LS (as shown in **Annexure III.**)

4. Discussion of Revised syllabus for Ph.D. students at BARC:

The committee discussed the revised syllabus for PhD (Life Sciences) of BARC and suggested Orientation Programme should include Fire-safety, Bio-safety, Radiation-safety and Cyber-safety as part of Induction programme. The revised syllabus approved by BOS-LS members will be forwarded to HBNI.
