Pilot Programme on "Teaching Assistantship in the Institute"

It is proposed to run a Pilot Programme on "Teaching Assistantship in the Institute" with active participation of the Post Doctoral Fellows & Senior Research Fellows of the Institute in Teaching Activities. The Eligibility Criteria, Goals, Modalities and Activities of the programme are explained below:

Goals of the Programme:

- To provide an opportunity to the Post Doctoral Fellows & Senior Research Fellows of the Institute to improve their teaching skills which will help them in gaining better careers.
- To strengthen the understanding of the Research Scholars towards specific areas of the subject which is possible through learning the subject in depth while preparing for teaching activity.
- To provide students attending the courses with additional help in the form of tutorial sessions and better feedback on assignments.
- To provide the faculty instructors with more flexibility in conducting the courses.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Post Doctoral Fellows & only those Senior Research Fellows of the Institute who are making satisfactory progress in their doctoral programme are eligible to function as Teaching Assistant.
- Participation is purely on voluntary basis.
- Nomination of the Teaching Assistant will be decided jointly by the Student Co-ordinator & faculty instructor of the course concerned in consultation with the proposed nominee and his/her academic guide.
- The Teaching Assistants will be entitled for an honorarium of Rs.2500/- per month.

Responsibilities of the Teaching Assistant:

- Correction of the Assignments
- Conducting the Tutorials
- Extending help in setting the Assignments
- At least one or two special lectures under the supervision of the faculty instructor.

- The faculty instructor & Teaching Assistant will mutually extend the co-operation depending on the area of the subject decided by them.
- The faculty members will review the success of the programme & guidelines prescribed at the end of each semester.

Dear Sir,

As you are aware, we are organizing this year's trip to Thekkady, Vagamon and Athirappilly Falls. Some 51 JRFs and SRFs have shown an interest in going for the trip, much more than the last year. For the travel, we request you to provide a 55 seater AC bus(similar to the last year's bus). Following is the rough itinerary that we wish to follow which you might need for booking the bus.

Thursday: leave from IMSc at 4:00 PM.

Friday: Reach Thekkady by 5 AM. Roam in Thekkady till 3:30 PM. Head towards Vagamon via Parumthumpara. Stay in Vagamon.

Saturday: Vagamon sight seeing. Stay in Vagamon.

Sunday: Head to Athirapilly waterfalls. Return towards IMSc by Valparai route by 4 PM.

Monday: Reach IMSc by 6 am.

One thing that needs to be taken care while booking the bus is, the road that we are traveling on will require a driver who is used to driving on the mountain roads. It would also be preferable to have two drivers as the journey is long.

In respect to accommodation, we have talked to a place in Vagamon which has agreed to provide accommodation at Rs 1500 per person per day on a sharing basis for two nights(same as the last year's price per person per day). The cost includes breakfast and dinner. We will also need to halt at some place in Thekkady for few hours when we reach there. The estimate of that would be Rs 300 per person. So the estimated cost of accommodation is Rs 1,66,800. The amount isn't the final price as it is subject to vary a bit.

I am attaching the list of JRFs/SRFs who have registered with us with a caution deposit of Rs 500 for the trip. Please let us know your thoughts and concerns(if any) on our plan.
